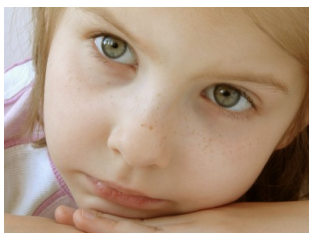


Our service is available to bereaved families **totally free of charge**, thereby ensuring accessibility to all.

We provide a **free** support programme for bereaved children and their families in South Warwickshire

Guy's Gift has been founded in recognition of the needs of younger members of our community who have been affected by a bereavement at some stage in their life.

We can provide:

- A free assessment of the needs of individual members of each family following a bereavement;
- Free support for individual members of each family;
- Free support and guidance in schools;
- Free telephone support and information;
- Free help in accessing other sources of support, if appropriate;
- Training for people who work with children;

How we work

Initially, our Practitioners will visit parents in their own home, to discuss both their needs and those of their children.

We will discuss openly and frankly with individuals the issues that can be addressed by our support programme. The help we offer will include one to one support and may also include structured workshops.

Bereaved families are welcome to contact us. We also invite referrals from professionals (with written authority from a parent/guardian of bereaved children).
